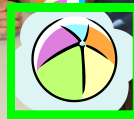

The Summer Jobs for Youth program provides disadvantaged youth aged 15-18 years of age with pre-employment training and a 6 week placement with post-employment support in a job that is most often their very first paid position. YES Employment Services will place over 240 young people through the SJFY program which is funded by the government of Ontario and managed by the Ministry of Children and Youth Services. Special thanks to all the employers who offer these students training and their first opportunity to gain real work experience and see what it's like to work in their field of interest.
