Workplace Hazardous Material Information System

On-line WHMIS takes approximately 1.5 hours to complete. You will be tested after each segment. After successful completion you will receive a certificate that satisfies provincial and federal legislative requirements for general WHMIS training.

WHMIS training is not just for factory workers. Many cleaning, landscaping, trade and hairdressing jobs require the use of hazardous chemicals and WHMIS certification is mandatory for these positions. Having WHMIS training on your resume shows potential employers that you are safety conscious.

SEGMENT #1

- Provides an introduction to WHMIS, a system used to inform individuals about hazardous chemicals. The duties and responsibilities of suppliers, employer and workers are explained.

SEGMENT #2

- Provides an overview of chemical hazards and explains how to avoid absorption (chemicals actually entering the body)

SEGMENT #3

- Informs trainees about proper labeling and information required for the worker who must handle controlled products.

SEGMENT #4

- Discusses additional information about controlled products which is contained on Material Safety Data sheets.
